

# Psalm 2

**1** Why do the heathen<sup>H1471</sup> rage<sup>H7283</sup>, and the people<sup>H3816</sup> imagine<sup>H1897</sup> a vain thing<sup>H7385</sup>? **2** The kings<sup>H4428</sup> of the earth<sup>H776</sup> set<sup>H3320</sup> themselves, and the rulers<sup>H7336</sup> take counsel<sup>H3245</sup> together<sup>H3162</sup>, against the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and against his anointed<sup>H4899</sup>, saying, **3** Let us break<sup>H5423</sup> their bands<sup>H4147</sup> asunder<sup>H5423</sup>, and cast away<sup>H7993</sup> their cords<sup>H5688</sup> from us. **4** He that sitteth<sup>H3427</sup> in the heavens<sup>H8064</sup> shall laugh<sup>H7832</sup>: the Lord<sup>H136</sup> shall have them in derision<sup>H3932</sup>. **5** Then shall he speak<sup>H1696</sup> unto them in his wrath<sup>H639</sup>, and vex<sup>H926</sup> them in his sore displeasure<sup>H2740</sup>. **6** Yet have I set<sup>H5258</sup> my king<sup>H4428</sup> upon my holy<sup>H6944</sup> hill<sup>H2022</sup> of Zion<sup>H6726</sup>.

**7** I will declare<sup>H5608</sup> the decree<sup>H2706</sup>: the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> hath said<sup>H559</sup> unto me, Thou art my Son<sup>H1121</sup>; this day<sup>H3117</sup> have I begotten<sup>H3205</sup> thee. **8** Ask<sup>H7592</sup> of me, and I shall give<sup>H5414</sup> thee the heathen<sup>H1471</sup> for thine inheritance<sup>H5159</sup>, and the uttermost parts<sup>H657</sup> of the earth<sup>H776</sup> for thy possession<sup>H272</sup>. **9** Thou shalt break<sup>H7489</sup> them with a rod<sup>H7626</sup> of iron<sup>H1270</sup>; thou shalt dash them in pieces<sup>H5310</sup> like a potter's<sup>H3335</sup> vessel<sup>H3627</sup>.

**10** Be wise<sup>H7919</sup> now therefore, O ye kings<sup>H4428</sup>: be instructed<sup>H3256</sup>, ye judges<sup>H8199</sup> of the earth<sup>H776</sup>. **11** Serve<sup>H5647</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> with fear<sup>H3374</sup>, and rejoice<sup>H1523</sup> with trembling<sup>H7461</sup>. **12** Kiss<sup>H5401</sup> the Son<sup>H1248</sup>, lest he be angry<sup>H599</sup>, and ye perish<sup>H6</sup> from the way<sup>H1870</sup>, when his wrath<sup>H639</sup> is kindled<sup>H1197</sup> but a little<sup>H4592</sup>. Blessed<sup>H835</sup> are all they that put their trust<sup>H2620</sup> in him.
