1 To the chief Musician<sup>H5329</sup>, A Psalm<sup>H4210</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup>. The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> hear<sup>H6030</sup> thee in the day<sup>H3117</sup> of trouble<sup>H6869</sup>, the name<sup>H8034</sup> of the God<sup>H430</sup> of Jacob<sup>H3290</sup> defend<sup>H7682</sup> thee;<sup>1</sup> 2 Send<sup>H7971</sup> thee help<sup>H5828</sup> from the sanctuary<sup>H6944</sup>, and strengthen<sup>H5582</sup> thee out of Zion<sup>H6726,23</sup>; 3 Remember<sup>H2142</sup> all thy offerings<sup>H4503</sup>, and accept<sup>H1878</sup> thy burnt sacrifice<sup>H5930</sup>; Selah<sup>H5542</sup>. 4 Grant<sup>H5414</sup> thee according to thine own heart<sup>H3824</sup>, and fulfil<sup>H4390</sup> all thy counsel<sup>H6098</sup>. 5 We will rejoice<sup>H7442</sup> in thy salvation<sup>H3444</sup>, and in the name<sup>H8034</sup> of our God<sup>H430</sup> we will set up our banners<sup>H1713</sup>: the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> fulfil<sup>H4390</sup> all thy petitions<sup>H4862</sup>.

6 Now know<sup>H3045</sup> I that the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> saveth<sup>H3467</sup> his anointed<sup>H4899</sup>; he will hear<sup>H6030</sup> him from his holy<sup>H6944</sup> heaven<sup>H8064</sup> with the saving<sup>H3468</sup> strength<sup>H1369</sup> of his right hand<sup>H3225</sup>. 7 Some trust in chariots<sup>H7393</sup>, and some in horses<sup>H5483</sup>: but we will remember<sup>H2142</sup> the name<sup>H8034</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> our God<sup>H430</sup>. 8 They are brought down<sup>H3766</sup> and fallen<sup>H5307</sup>: but we are risen<sup>H6965</sup>, and stand upright<sup>H5749</sup>. 9 Save<sup>H3467</sup>, LORD<sup>H3068</sup>: let the king<sup>H4428</sup> hear<sup>H6030</sup> us when<sup>H3117</sup> we call<sup>H7121</sup>.
