**1** A Psalm of David<sup>H1732</sup>, when he changed<sup>H8138</sup> his behaviour<sup>H2940</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> Abimelech<sup>H40</sup>; who drove him away<sup>H1644</sup>, and he departed<sup>H3212</sup>. I will bless<sup>H1288</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> at all times<sup>H6256</sup>: his praise<sup>H8416</sup> shall continually<sup>H8548</sup> be in my mouth<sup>H6310</sup>.<sup>1</sup> **2** My soul<sup>H5315</sup> shall make her boast<sup>H1984</sup> in the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>: the humble<sup>H6035</sup> shall hear<sup>H8085</sup> thereof, and be glad<sup>H8055</sup>. **3** O magnify<sup>H1431</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> with me, and let us exalt<sup>H7311</sup> his name<sup>H8034</sup> together<sup>H3162</sup>. **4** I sought<sup>H1875</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, and he heard<sup>H6030</sup> me, and delivered<sup>H5337</sup> me from all my fears<sup>H4035</sup>. **5** They looked<sup>H5027</sup> unto him, and were lightened<sup>H5102</sup>: and their faces<sup>H6440</sup> were not ashamed<sup>H2659</sup>.<sup>2</sup> **6** This poor man<sup>H6041</sup> cried<sup>H7121</sup>, and the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> heard<sup>H8085</sup> him, and saved<sup>H3467</sup> him out of all his troubles<sup>H6869</sup>. **7** The angel<sup>H4397</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> encampeth<sup>H2583</sup> round about<sup>H5439</sup> them that fear<sup>H3373</sup> him, and delivereth<sup>H2502</sup> them. **8** O taste<sup>H2938</sup> and see<sup>H7200</sup> that the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> is good<sup>H2896</sup>: blessed<sup>H835</sup> is the man<sup>H1397</sup> that trusteth<sup>H2620</sup> in him. **9** O fear<sup>H3372</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, ye his saints<sup>H6918</sup>: for there is no want<sup>H4270</sup> to them that fear<sup>H3373</sup> him. **10** The young lions<sup>H3715</sup> do lack<sup>H7326</sup>, and suffer hunger<sup>H7456</sup>: but they that seek<sup>H1875</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> shall not want<sup>H2637</sup> any good<sup>H2896</sup> thing.

**11** Come<sup>H3212</sup>, ye children<sup>H1121</sup>, hearken<sup>H8085</sup> unto me: I will teach<sup>H3925</sup> you the fear<sup>H3374</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. **12** What man<sup>H376</sup> is he that desireth<sup>H2655</sup> life<sup>H2416</sup>, and loveth<sup>H157</sup> many days<sup>H3117</sup>, that he may see<sup>H7200</sup> good<sup>H2896</sup>? **13** Keep<sup>H5341</sup> thy tongue<sup>H3956</sup> from evil<sup>H7451</sup>, and thy lips<sup>H8193</sup> from speaking<sup>H1696</sup> guile<sup>H4820</sup>. **14** Depart<sup>H5493</sup> from evil<sup>H7451</sup>, and do<sup>H6213</sup> good<sup>H2896</sup>; seek<sup>H1245</sup> peace<sup>H7965</sup>, and pursue<sup>H7291</sup> it. **15** The eyes<sup>H5869</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> are upon the righteous<sup>H6662</sup>, and his ears<sup>H241</sup> are open unto their cry<sup>H7775</sup>. **16** The face<sup>H6440</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> is against them that do<sup>H6213</sup> evil<sup>H7451</sup>, to cut off<sup>H3772</sup> the remembrance<sup>H2143</sup> of them from the earth<sup>H776</sup>. **17** The righteous cry<sup>H6817</sup>, and the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> heareth<sup>H8085</sup>, and delivereth<sup>H5337</sup> them out of all their troubles<sup>H6869</sup>. **18** The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> is nigh<sup>H7138</sup> unto them that are of a broken<sup>H7665</sup> heart<sup>H3820</sup>; and saveth<sup>H3467</sup> such as be of a contrite<sup>H1793</sup> spirit<sup>H7307,34</sup> **19** Many<sup>H7227</sup> are the afflictions<sup>H7451</sup> of the righteous<sup>H6662</sup>: but the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> delivereth<sup>H5337</sup> him out of them all. **20** He keepeth<sup>H8104</sup> all his bones<sup>H6106</sup>: not one<sup>H259</sup> of them<sup>H2007</sup> is broken<sup>H7665</sup>. **21** Evil<sup>H7451</sup> shall slay<sup>H4191</sup> the wicked<sup>H7563</sup>: and they that hate<sup>H8130</sup> the righteous<sup>H6662</sup> shall be desolate<sup>H816,5</sup>.
