

# Psalm 36

1 To the chief Musician<sup>H5329</sup>, A Psalm of David<sup>H1732</sup> the servant<sup>H5650</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>. The transgression<sup>H6588</sup> of the wicked<sup>H7563</sup> saith<sup>H5002</sup> within<sup>H7130</sup> my heart<sup>H3820</sup>, that there is no fear<sup>H6343</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup> before his eyes<sup>H5869</sup>. 2 For he flattereth<sup>H2505</sup> himself in his own eyes<sup>H5869</sup>, until his iniquity<sup>H5771</sup> be found<sup>H4672</sup> to be hateful<sup>H8130</sup>. 3 The words<sup>H1697</sup> of his mouth<sup>H6310</sup> are iniquity<sup>H205</sup> and deceit<sup>H4820</sup>: he hath left off<sup>H2308</sup> to be wise<sup>H7919</sup>, and to do good<sup>H3190</sup>. 4 He deviseth<sup>H2803</sup> mischief<sup>H205</sup> upon his bed<sup>H4904</sup>; he setteth<sup>H3320</sup> himself in a way<sup>H1870</sup> that is not good<sup>H2896</sup>; he abhorreth<sup>H3988</sup> not evil<sup>H7451</sup>. 2

5 Thy mercy<sup>H2617</sup>, O LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, is in the heavens<sup>H8064</sup>; and thy faithfulness<sup>H530</sup> reacheth unto the clouds<sup>H7834</sup>. 6 Thy righteousness<sup>H6666</sup> is like the great<sup>H410</sup> mountains<sup>H2042</sup>; thy judgments<sup>H4941</sup> are a great<sup>H7227</sup> deep<sup>H8415</sup>: O LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, thou preservest<sup>H3467</sup> man<sup>H120</sup> and beast<sup>H929</sup>. 7 How excellent<sup>H3368</sup> is thy lovingkindness<sup>H2617</sup>, O God<sup>H430</sup>! therefore the children<sup>H1121</sup> of men<sup>H120</sup> put their trust<sup>H2620</sup> under the shadow<sup>H6738</sup> of thy wings<sup>H3671</sup>. 8 They shall be abundantly satisfied<sup>H7301</sup> with the fatness<sup>H1880</sup> of thy house<sup>H1004</sup>; and thou shalt make them drink<sup>H8248</sup> of the river<sup>H5158</sup> of thy pleasures<sup>H5730</sup>. 9 For with thee is the fountain<sup>H4726</sup> of life<sup>H2416</sup>: in thy light<sup>H216</sup> shall we see<sup>H7200</sup> light<sup>H216</sup>. 10 O continue<sup>H4900</sup> thy lovingkindness<sup>H2617</sup> unto them that know<sup>H3045</sup> thee; and thy righteousness<sup>H6666</sup> to the upright<sup>H3477</sup> in heart<sup>H3820</sup>. 11 Let not the foot<sup>H7272</sup> of pride<sup>H1346</sup> come<sup>H935</sup> against me, and let not the hand<sup>H3027</sup> of the wicked<sup>H7563</sup> remove<sup>H5110</sup> me. 12 There are the workers<sup>H6466</sup> of iniquity<sup>H205</sup> fallen<sup>H5307</sup>: they are cast down<sup>H1760</sup>, and shall not be able<sup>H3201</sup> to rise<sup>H6965</sup>.
