5 Mine enemies<sup>H341</sup> speak<sup>H559</sup> evil<sup>H7451</sup> of me, When shall he die<sup>H4191</sup>, and his name<sup>H8034</sup> perish<sup>H6</sup>? 6 And if he come<sup>H935</sup> to see<sup>H7200</sup> me, he speaketh<sup>H1696</sup> vanity<sup>H7723</sup>: his heart<sup>H3820</sup> gathereth<sup>H6908</sup> iniquity<sup>H205</sup> to itself; when he goeth<sup>H3318</sup> abroad<sup>H2351</sup>, he telleth<sup>H1696</sup> it. 7 All that hate<sup>H8130</sup> me whisper<sup>H3907</sup> together<sup>H3162</sup> against me: against me do they devise<sup>H2803</sup> my hurt<sup>H7451</sup>.<sup>5</sup> 8 An evil<sup>H1100</sup> disease<sup>H1697</sup>, say they, cleaveth fast<sup>H3332</sup> unto him: and now that he lieth<sup>H7901</sup> he shall rise up<sup>H6965</sup> no more<sup>H3254</sup>.<sup>6</sup> 9 Yea, mine own familiar<sup>H7965</sup> friend<sup>H376</sup>, in whom I trusted<sup>H982</sup>, which did eat<sup>H398</sup> of my bread<sup>H3899</sup>, hath lifted up<sup>H1431</sup> his heel<sup>H6119</sup> against me.<sup>78</sup> 10 But thou, O LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, be merciful<sup>H2603</sup> unto me, and raise me up<sup>H6965</sup>, that I may requite<sup>H7999</sup> them. 11 By this I know<sup>H3045</sup> that thou favourest<sup>H2654</sup> me, because mine enemy<sup>H341</sup> doth not triumph<sup>H7321</sup> over me. 12 And as for me, thou upholdest<sup>H8551</sup> me in mine integrity<sup>H8537</sup>, and settest<sup>H5324</sup> me before thy face<sup>H6440</sup> for ever<sup>H5769</sup>. 13 Blessed<sup>H1288</sup> be the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> God<sup>H430</sup> of Israel<sup>H3478</sup> from everlasting<sup>H5769</sup>, and to everlasting<sup>H5769</sup>.
