1 To the chief Musician<sup>H5329</sup> for the sons<sup>H1121</sup> of Korah<sup>H7141</sup>, A Song<sup>H7892</sup> upon Alamoth<sup>H5961</sup>. God<sup>H430</sup> is our refuge<sup>H4268</sup> and strength<sup>H5797</sup>, a very<sup>H3966</sup> present<sup>H4672</sup> help<sup>H5833</sup> in trouble<sup>H6869</sup>. 1 2 Therefore will not we fear<sup>H3372</sup>, though the earth<sup>H776</sup> be removed<sup>H4171</sup>, and though the mountains<sup>H2022</sup> be carried<sup>H4131</sup> into the midst<sup>H3820</sup> of the sea<sup>H3220</sup>, 2 3 Though the waters<sup>H4325</sup> thereof roar<sup>H1993</sup> and be troubled<sup>H2560</sup>, though the mountains<sup>H2022</sup> shake<sup>H7493</sup> with the swelling<sup>H1346</sup> thereof. Selah<sup>H5542</sup>. 4 There is a river<sup>H5104</sup>, the streams<sup>H6388</sup> whereof shall make glad<sup>H8055</sup> the city<sup>H5892</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup>, the holy<sup>H6918</sup> place of the tabernacles<sup>H4908</sup> of the most High<sup>H5945</sup>. 5 God<sup>H430</sup> is in the midst<sup>H7130</sup> of her; she shall not be moved<sup>H4131</sup>: God<sup>H430</sup> shall help<sup>H5826</sup> her, and that right<sup>H6437</sup> early<sup>H1242</sup>. 3

6 The heathen<sup>H1471</sup> raged<sup>H1993</sup>, the kingdoms<sup>H4467</sup> were moved<sup>H4131</sup>: he uttered<sup>H5414</sup> his voice<sup>H6963</sup>, the earth<sup>H776</sup> melted<sup>H4127</sup>. 7 The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> of hosts<sup>H6635</sup> is with us; the God<sup>H430</sup> of Jacob<sup>H3290</sup> is our refuge<sup>H4869</sup>. Selah<sup>H5542</sup>. 4 8 Come<sup>H3212</sup>, behold<sup>H2372</sup> the works<sup>H4659</sup> of the LORD<sup>H3068</sup>, what desolations<sup>H8047</sup> he hath made<sup>H7760</sup> in the earth<sup>H776</sup>. 9 He maketh wars<sup>H4421</sup> to cease<sup>H7673</sup> unto the end<sup>H7097</sup> of the earth<sup>H776</sup>; he breaketh<sup>H7665</sup> the bow<sup>H7198</sup>, and cutteth<sup>H7112</sup> the spear<sup>H2595</sup> in sunder<sup>H7112</sup>; he burneth<sup>H8313</sup> the chariot<sup>H5699</sup> in the fire<sup>H784</sup>. 10 Be still<sup>H7503</sup>, and know<sup>H3045</sup> that I am God<sup>H430</sup>: I will be exalted<sup>H7311</sup> among the heathen<sup>H1471</sup>, I will be exalted<sup>H7311</sup> in the earth<sup>H776</sup>. 11 The LORD<sup>H3068</sup> of hosts<sup>H6635</sup> is with us; the God<sup>H430</sup> of Jacob<sup>H3290</sup> is our refuge<sup>H4869</sup>.
