Selah H5542. 4 Thou lovest H157 all devouring H1105 words H1697, O thou deceitful H4820 tongue H3956. 5 God H410 shall likewise destroy H5422 thee for ever H5331, he shall take thee away H2846, and pluck thee out H5255 of thy dwelling place H168, and root thee out H8327 of the land H7776 of the living H2416.
