1 To the chief Musician<sup>H5329</sup>, Maschil<sup>H4905</sup>, A Psalm of David<sup>H1732</sup>, when Doeg<sup>H1673</sup> the Edomite<sup>H130</sup> came<sup>H935</sup> and told<sup>H5046</sup> Saul<sup>H7586</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup> unto him, David<sup>H1732</sup> is come<sup>H935</sup> to the house<sup>H1004</sup> of Ahimelech<sup>H288</sup>. Why boastest<sup>H1984</sup> thou thyself in mischief<sup>H7451</sup>, O mighty<sup>H1368</sup> man? the goodness<sup>H2617</sup> of God<sup>H410</sup> endureth continually<sup>H3117</sup>. 2 Thy tongue<sup>H3956</sup> deviseth<sup>H2803</sup> mischiefs<sup>H1942</sup>; like a sharp<sup>H3913</sup> razor<sup>H8593</sup>, working<sup>H6213</sup> deceitfully<sup>H7423</sup>. 3 Thou lovest<sup>H157</sup> evil<sup>H7451</sup> more than good<sup>H2896</sup>, and lying<sup>H8267</sup> rather than to speak<sup>H1696</sup> righteousness<sup>H6664</sup>. Selah<sup>H5542</sup>. 4 Thou lovest<sup>H157</sup> all devouring<sup>H1105</sup> words<sup>H1697</sup>, O thou deceitful<sup>H4820</sup> tongue<sup>H3956</sup>. 1 5 God<sup>H410</sup> shall likewise destroy<sup>H5422</sup> thee for ever<sup>H5331</sup>, he shall take thee away<sup>H2846</sup>, and pluck thee out<sup>H5255</sup> of thy dwelling place<sup>H168</sup>, and root thee out<sup>H8327</sup> of the land<sup>H776</sup> of the living<sup>H2416</sup>. 6 The righteous<sup>H6662</sup> also shall see<sup>H7200</sup>, and fear<sup>H3372</sup>, and shall laugh<sup>H7832</sup> at him: 7 Lo, this is the man<sup>H1397</sup> that made<sup>H7760</sup> not God<sup>H430</sup> his strength<sup>H4581</sup>, but trusted<sup>H982</sup> in the abundance<sup>H7230</sup> of his riches<sup>H6239</sup>, and strengthened<sup>H5810</sup> himself in his wickedness<sup>H1942</sup>. 3 8 But I am like a green<sup>H7488</sup> olive tree<sup>H2132</sup> in the house<sup>H1004</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup>: I trust<sup>H982</sup> in the mercy<sup>H2617</sup> of God<sup>H430</sup> for ever<sup>H5769</sup> and ever<sup>H5703</sup>. 9 I will praise<sup>H3034</sup> thee for ever<sup>H5769</sup>, because thou hast done<sup>H6213</sup> it: and I will wait<sup>H6960</sup> on thy name<sup>H8034</sup>, for it is good<sup>H2896</sup> before thy saints<sup>H2623</sup>.
