1 To the chief Musician<sup>H5329</sup>, Altaschith<sup>H516</sup>, Michtam<sup>H4387</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup>, when he fled<sup>H1272</sup> from<sup>H6440</sup> Saul<sup>H7586</sup> in the cave<sup>H4631</sup>. Be merciful<sup>H2603</sup> unto me, O God<sup>H430</sup>, be merciful<sup>H2603</sup> unto me: for my soul<sup>H5315</sup> trusteth<sup>H2620</sup> in thee: yea, in the shadow<sup>H6738</sup> of thy wings<sup>H3671</sup> will I make my refuge<sup>H2620</sup>, until these calamities<sup>H1942</sup> be overpast<sup>H5674</sup>. 2 I will cry<sup>H7121</sup> unto God<sup>H430</sup> most high<sup>H5945</sup>; unto God<sup>H410</sup> that performeth<sup>H1584</sup> all things for me. 3 He shall send<sup>H7971</sup> from heaven<sup>H8064</sup>, and save<sup>H3467</sup> me from the reproach<sup>H2778</sup> of him that would swallow me up<sup>H7602</sup>. Selah<sup>H5542</sup>. God<sup>H430</sup> shall send forth<sup>H7971</sup> his mercy<sup>H2617</sup> and his truth<sup>H571</sup>. 4 My soul<sup>H5315</sup> is among<sup>H8432</sup> lions<sup>H3833</sup>: and I lie<sup>H7901</sup> even among them that are set on fire<sup>H3857</sup>, even the sons<sup>H1121</sup> of men<sup>H120</sup>, whose teeth<sup>H8127</sup> are spears<sup>H2595</sup> and arrows<sup>H2671</sup>, and their tongue<sup>H3956</sup> a sharp<sup>H2299</sup> sword<sup>H2719</sup>. 5 Be thou exalted<sup>H7311</sup>, O God<sup>H430</sup>, above the heavens<sup>H8064</sup>; let thy glory<sup>H3519</sup> be above all the earth<sup>H776</sup>. 6 They have prepared<sup>H3559</sup> a net<sup>H7568</sup> for my steps<sup>H6471</sup>; my soul<sup>H5315</sup> is bowed down<sup>H3721</sup>: they have digged<sup>H3738</sup> a pit<sup>H7882</sup> before<sup>H6440</sup> me, into the midst<sup>H8432</sup> whereof they are fallen<sup>H5307</sup> themselves. 7 My heart<sup>H3820</sup> is fixed<sup>H3559</sup>, O God<sup>H430</sup>, my heart<sup>H3820</sup> is fixed<sup>H3559</sup>: I will sing<sup>H7891</sup> and give praise<sup>H2167</sup>. 8 Awake up<sup>H5782</sup>, my glory<sup>H3519</sup>; awake<sup>H5782</sup>, psaltery<sup>H5035</sup> and harp<sup>H3658</sup>: I myself will awake<sup>H5782</sup> early<sup>H7837</sup>. 9 I will praise<sup>H3034</sup> thee, O Lord<sup>H136</sup>, among the people<sup>H5971</sup>: I will sing<sup>H2167</sup> unto thee among the nations<sup>H3816</sup>. 10 For thy mercy<sup>H2617</sup> is great<sup>H1419</sup> unto the heavens<sup>H8064</sup>, and thy truth<sup>H571</sup> unto the clouds<sup>H7834</sup>. 11 Be thou exalted<sup>H7311</sup>, O God<sup>H430</sup>, above the heavens<sup>H8064</sup>: let thy glory<sup>H3519</sup> be above all the earth<sup>H776</sup>.
