**1** A Psalm<sup>H4210</sup> of David<sup>H1732</sup>, when he was in the wilderness<sup>H4057</sup> of Judah<sup>H3063</sup>. O God<sup>H430</sup>, thou art my God<sup>H410</sup>; early will I seek<sup>H7836</sup> thee: my soul<sup>H5315</sup> thirsteth<sup>H6770</sup> for thee, my flesh<sup>H1320</sup> longeth<sup>H3642</sup> for thee in a dry<sup>H6723</sup> and thirsty<sup>H5889</sup> land<sup>H776</sup>, where no<sup>H1097</sup> water<sup>H4325</sup> is;<sup>12</sup> **2** To see<sup>H7200</sup> thy power<sup>H5797</sup> and thy glory<sup>H3519</sup>, so as I have seen<sup>H2372</sup> thee in the sanctuary<sup>H6944</sup>.

**3** Because thy lovingkindness<sup>H2617</sup> is better<sup>H2896</sup> than life<sup>H2416</sup>, my lips<sup>H8193</sup> shall praise<sup>H7623</sup> thee. **4** Thus will I bless<sup>H1288</sup> thee while I live<sup>H2416</sup>: I will lift up<sup>H5375</sup> my hands<sup>H3709</sup> in thy name<sup>H8034</sup>. **5** My soul<sup>H5315</sup> shall be satisfied<sup>H7646</sup> as with marrow<sup>H2459</sup> and fatness<sup>H1880</sup>; and my mouth<sup>H6310</sup> shall praise<sup>H1984</sup> thee with joyful<sup>H7445</sup> lips<sup>H8193</sup>. **6** When I remember<sup>H2142</sup> thee upon my bed<sup>H3326</sup>, and meditate<sup>H1897</sup> on thee in the night watches<sup>H821</sup>.

**7** Because thou hast been my help<sup>H5833</sup>, therefore in the shadow<sup>H6738</sup> of thy wings<sup>H3671</sup> will I rejoice<sup>H7442</sup>. **8** My soul<sup>H5315</sup> followeth hard<sup>H1692</sup> after<sup>H310</sup> thee: thy right hand<sup>H3225</sup> upholdeth<sup>H8551</sup> me. **9** But those that seek<sup>H1245</sup> my soul<sup>H5315</sup>, to destroy<sup>H7722</sup> it, shall go<sup>H935</sup> into the lower parts<sup>H8482</sup> of the earth<sup>H776</sup>. **10** They shall fall<sup>H5064</sup> by the sword<sup>H3027 H2719</sup>: they shall be a portion<sup>H4521</sup> for foxes<sup>H7776.4</sup> **11** But the king<sup>H4428</sup> shall rejoice<sup>H8055</sup> in God<sup>H430</sup>; every one that sweareth<sup>H7650</sup> by him shall glory<sup>H1984</sup>: but the mouth<sup>H6310</sup> of them that speak<sup>H1696</sup> lies<sup>H8267</sup> shall be stopped<sup>H5534</sup>.
