

# Psalm 76

1 To the chief Musician<sup>H5329</sup> on Neginoth<sup>H5058</sup>, A Psalm<sup>H4210</sup> or Song<sup>H7892</sup> of Asaph<sup>H623</sup>. In Judah<sup>H3063</sup> is God<sup>H430</sup> known<sup>H3045</sup>: his name<sup>H8034</sup> is great<sup>H1419</sup> in Israel<sup>H3478</sup>. 1 2 In Salem<sup>H8004</sup> also is his tabernacle<sup>H5520</sup>, and his dwelling place<sup>H4585</sup> in Zion<sup>H6726</sup>. 3 There brake<sup>H7665</sup> he the arrows<sup>H7565</sup> of the bow<sup>H7198</sup>, the shield<sup>H4043</sup>, and the sword<sup>H2719</sup>, and the battle<sup>H4421</sup>. Selah<sup>H5542</sup>. 4 Thou art more glorious<sup>H215</sup> and excellent<sup>H1117</sup> than the mountains<sup>H2042</sup> of prey<sup>H2964</sup>. 5 The stouthearted<sup>H47 H3820</sup> are spoiled<sup>H7997</sup>, they have slept<sup>H5123</sup> their sleep<sup>H8142</sup>: and none of the men<sup>H582</sup> of might<sup>H2428</sup> have found<sup>H4672</sup> their hands<sup>H3027</sup>. 6 At thy rebuke<sup>H1606</sup>, O God<sup>H430</sup> of Jacob<sup>H3290</sup>, both the chariot<sup>H7393</sup> and horse<sup>H5483</sup> are cast into a dead sleep<sup>H7290</sup>.

7 Thou, even thou, art to be feared<sup>H3372</sup>: and who may stand<sup>H5975</sup> in thy sight<sup>H6440</sup> when<sup>H227</sup> once thou art angry<sup>H639</sup>? 8 Thou didst cause judgment<sup>H1779</sup> to be heard<sup>H8085</sup> from heaven<sup>H8064</sup>; the earth<sup>H776</sup> feared<sup>H3372</sup>, and was still<sup>H8252</sup>. 9 When God<sup>H430</sup> arose<sup>H6965</sup> to judgment<sup>H4941</sup>, to save<sup>H3467</sup> all the meek<sup>H6035</sup> of the earth<sup>H776</sup>. Selah<sup>H5542</sup>. 10 Surely the wrath<sup>H2534</sup> of man<sup>H120</sup> shall praise<sup>H3034</sup> thee: the remainder<sup>H7611</sup> of wrath<sup>H2534</sup> shalt thou restrain<sup>H2296</sup>. 11 Vow<sup>H5087</sup>, and pay<sup>H7999</sup> unto the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> your God<sup>H430</sup>: let all that be round about<sup>H5439</sup> him bring<sup>H2986</sup> presents<sup>H7862</sup> unto him that ought to be feared<sup>H4172</sup>. 2 12 He shall cut off<sup>H1219</sup> the spirit<sup>H7307</sup> of princes<sup>H5057</sup>: he is terrible<sup>H3372</sup> to the kings<sup>H4428</sup> of the earth<sup>H776</sup>.
