## Zechariah 5

1 Then I turned<sup>H7725</sup>, and lifted up<sup>H5375</sup> mine eyes<sup>H5869</sup>, and looked<sup>H7200</sup>, and behold a flying<sup>H5774</sup> roll<sup>H4039</sup>. 2 And he said<sup>H559</sup> unto me, What seest<sup>H7200</sup> thou? And I answered<sup>H559</sup>, I see<sup>H7200</sup> a flying<sup>H5774</sup> roll<sup>H4039</sup>; the length<sup>H753</sup> thereof is twenty<sup>H6242</sup> cubits<sup>H520</sup>, and the breadth<sup>H7341</sup> thereof ten<sup>H6235</sup> cubits<sup>H520</sup>. 3 Then said<sup>H559</sup> he unto me, This is the curse<sup>H423</sup> that goeth forth<sup>H3318</sup> over the face<sup>H6440</sup> of the whole earth<sup>H776</sup>: for every one that stealeth<sup>H1589</sup> shall be cut off<sup>H5352</sup> as on this side according<sup>H3644</sup> to it; and every one that sweareth<sup>H7650</sup> shall be cut off<sup>H5352</sup> as on that side according<sup>H3644</sup> to it.<sup>1</sup> 4 I will bring it forth<sup>H3318</sup>, saith<sup>H5002</sup> the LORD<sup>H3068</sup> of hosts<sup>H6635</sup>, and it shall enter<sup>H935</sup> into the house<sup>H1004</sup> of the thief<sup>H1590</sup>, and into the house<sup>H1004</sup> of him that sweareth<sup>H7650</sup> falsely<sup>H8267</sup> by my name<sup>H8034</sup>: and it shall remain<sup>H3885</sup> in the midst<sup>H8432</sup> of his house<sup>H1004</sup>, and shall consume<sup>H3615</sup> it with the timber<sup>H6086</sup> thereof and the stones<sup>H68</sup> thereof.

5 Then the angel<sup>H4397</sup> that talked<sup>H1696</sup> with me went forth<sup>H3318</sup>, and said<sup>H559</sup> unto me, Lift up<sup>H5375</sup> now thine eyes<sup>H5869</sup>, and see<sup>H7200</sup> what is this that goeth forth<sup>H3318</sup>. 6 And I said<sup>H559</sup>, What is it? And he said<sup>H559</sup>, This is an ephah<sup>H374</sup> that goeth forth<sup>H3318</sup>. He said<sup>H559</sup> moreover, This is their resemblance<sup>H5869</sup> through all the earth<sup>H776</sup>. 7 And, behold, there was lifted up<sup>H5375</sup> a talent<sup>H3603</sup> of lead<sup>H5777</sup>: and this is a<sup>H259</sup> woman<sup>H802</sup> that sitteth<sup>H3427</sup> in the midst<sup>H8432</sup> of the ephah<sup>H374</sup>? 8 And he said<sup>H559</sup>, This is wickedness<sup>H7564</sup>. And he cast<sup>H7993</sup> it into the midst<sup>H8432</sup> of the ephah<sup>H374</sup>; and he cast<sup>H7993</sup> the weight<sup>H68</sup> of lead<sup>H5777</sup> upon the mouth<sup>H6310</sup> thereof. 9 Then lifted I up<sup>H5375</sup> mine eyes<sup>H5869</sup>, and looked<sup>H7200</sup>, and, behold, there came out<sup>H3318</sup> two<sup>H8147</sup> women<sup>H802</sup>, and the wind<sup>H7307</sup> was in their wings<sup>H3671</sup>; for they had<sup>H2007</sup> wings<sup>H3671</sup> like the wings<sup>H3671</sup> of a stork<sup>H2624</sup>: and they lifted up<sup>H5375</sup> the ephah<sup>H374</sup> between the earth<sup>H776</sup> and the heaven<sup>H8064</sup>. 10 Then said<sup>H559</sup> I to the angel<sup>H4397</sup> that talked<sup>H1696</sup> with me, Whither do these bear<sup>H3212</sup> the ephah<sup>H374</sup>? 11 And he said<sup>H559</sup> unto me, To build<sup>H1129</sup> it an house<sup>H1004</sup> in the land<sup>H776</sup> of Shinar<sup>H8152</sup>: and it shall be established<sup>H3559</sup>, and set<sup>H3240</sup> there upon her own base<sup>H3369</sup>.
